



# Halloween Night in SALEM Massachusetts

This year the City of Salem is working with Radio 92.9 to present Main Stage entertainment featuring Dancin' Nancy, a Dave Matthews Band cover band.

Residents should be aware of the following set-up and road-closure schedule for Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>:

10:00 AM Stage, generator, and sound system load into Washington Street at Federal Street. One lane of northbound traffic will be kept open, southbound traffic will not be affected. Washington Street will be closed to vehicular traffic in the later afternoon.

Please be aware that we will be testing sound volume levels intermittently during the day. Radio 92.9 will be broadcasted over the sound system beginning at 4pm.

7:00 – 10:00 PM	<b>Live music around town:</b> Total Entertainment DJ on Derby Street; DJ Doug on Salem Common; Undercover Band on Front Street; Grateful Ted & Britannica on Hawthorne Boulevard
7:30 PM	<b>Opening Act on the Main Stage</b> Presented by Radio 92.9 top of Washington Street, at Federal Street
9:00 PM	<b>The Dancin' Nancy Band on the Main Stage</b> presented by Radio 92.9
10:45 PM	<b>Fireworks</b> over the North River
11:00 PM	<b>Trains begin departing</b> for Boston and points North

**The Salem Police Department anticipates street closures in the downtown to take effect at approximately 4:00 PM.** Closures may happen earlier if public safety requires it.

## **The City of Salem is planning a safe Halloween celebration.**

Participants in Salem's Halloween night festivities are reminded of the following:

- **NO WEAPONS:** Omit any weapons – fake and real – from costumes, as they will be confiscated.
- **NO PUBLIC DRINKING:** Public consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.
- **BE CONSIDERATE:** Salem is a residential city – be considerate of private property and downtown residents.
- **COME EARLY:** To make the most out of your Halloween experience in Salem, plan to arrive no later than 8:30 pm, and plan to depart after the finale at 10:50 pm.
- **PLAN YOUR DEPARTURE:** The public Halloween celebration ends with the fireworks at 10:45 PM. Police will begin clearing the streets and sidewalks at that time.
- **TRIPLE FINES:** From October 29 – November 1 citations for illegal behavior – including public drinking, vandalism, and littering – will have tripled fines, up to \$300, associated with them.
